※ If you cannot print it, you will fill it in when you enroll. Even so, please read the whole form before you come.

☐ Advance declaration of illness and symptoms (If any of these is found after your lessons have started, you may be expelled from the school, and your license may be refused or its issue postponed.) If any item below applies to you, you may first need a “driving aptitude consultation” at the Driver’s License Center for the area where your address is registered. If any of these symptoms is found after you enroll, you may not be able to get a license. Please contact us and check before you enroll. 1. In the past 5 years, you have lost consciousness because of an illness (including symptoms caused by treatment for an illness), or for no clear reason. 2. In the past 5 years, an illness has left you temporarily unable to move all or part of your body as you wanted to. 3. In the past 5 years, there was a week in which you fell asleep 3 or more times while you were active during the day, even though you had had enough sleep. 4. In the past 1 year, either of the following has applied to you: On 3 or more occasions, you drank alcohol repeatedly and kept alcohol in your body continuously for 3 days or more. On 3 or more occasions, you drank alcohol even though a doctor had told you to stop drinking as part of treatment for an illness. 5. Because of an illness, a doctor or other medical professional has advised you not to get a driver’s license, or not to drive. 6. You are pregnant and have not obtained your doctor’s permission (confirmation). 7. Apart from the above, you have any physical or mental concern that may make driving lessons (classroom or in-car) difficult.
☐ Accidents, violations and penalties before you enroll (If any of these is found after your lessons have started, you may be expelled, and your license may be refused or postponed.) If you have ever committed a traffic violation such as driving without a license, or received an administrative penalty, check the points below before you enroll. 1. If your driver’s license has been revoked or refused in the past, you cannot take the driver’s license test unless you complete the “Course for Drivers Whose License Has Been Revoked (for re-acquisition)”. Also, if you are still within a disqualification period, or you have traffic violations, you must contact the Driver’s License Center for the area where your address is registered — yourself, and before you enroll — to check whether you can get a license. 2. Under a local government ordinance, we refuse enrollment to anyone who belongs to an organized crime group, a bosozoku (illegal street-racing gang) or any other anti-social group, or who takes part in the activities of such a group. Also, if you commit a crime, behave in a way that disturbs other people, or break any of our rules, regulations or school rules after you enroll, you will be expelled.
☐ Training fees, withdrawal from the school, etc. 1. The fee we charge for each type of training covers the enrollment fee, classroom and in-car lesson fees, the completion test and graduation test fees, certificate fees, photograph fees, textbook fees, the aptitude test fee, etc. What is included differs according to the license you are getting and the license you already hold. 2. Normally you pay no extra charges: the residential course plan covers the extra lessons and retests you need before you graduate. (※ This is not a guarantee that you will graduate.) You pay separately only for costs that arise from your own circumstances — for example, cancelling a lesson on the day, or optional lessons, extra lessons and retests that you ask for. Under our separate school rules, pledge and residential course terms, you may also have to pay other charges arising from your own circumstances (a stay-adjustment fee for extra nights, cancellation fees, handling fees, etc.). 3. If you leave the school before graduating (this includes your training period running out, and transferring to another school), you must pay the withdrawal fee (cancellation fee) that we set. Of the fees you have already paid, we do not refund these: lessons and tests you have taken, the enrollment fee, teaching materials, photographs, cancellation fees, accommodation, etc. (If you make a false declaration, break the terms or regulations, cause a traffic accident or violation, commit a crime, etc., you will be expelled.) If you are expelled, we give no refund, pay no compensation and carry out no transfer procedures at all. (You must still pay any fees that are due.) Your training also has a time limit, which starts on your first day of lessons. (If it runs out, you must leave the school, and the withdrawal rules above apply — you pay the withdrawal fee and get no refund for the parts already used. Please note this carefully.) 4. If you change from standard manual (MT) to automatic-only (AT) for reasons of your own, we cannot refund the difference in the fees. A fee may also be charged for changing from standard manual (MT) to automatic-only (AT). (The fee differs depending on the school you applied to.) 5. We will pay your travel expenses by the method we specify. We will send you an email explaining how to receive the money. If you do not claim it within 30 days of that email arriving, payment will be stopped. Once more than 30 days have passed, we cannot pay it again. 6. For details of the extra fees above, and of what the plan guarantees, please check the QR code below.
☐ If you become unwell while you are enrolled at the school 1. If you feel different from usual — for example fever, sore throat or headache — tell a staff member immediately and follow their instructions. 2. If staff decide that you should go home, please go home promptly. If traveling is difficult, please ask a parent or guardian to come and pick you up. 3. When you have recovered, contact the school and check when you may come back. 4. If it is difficult for you to come back to the school, you will be expelled. (No refund is given — see “Training fees, withdrawal from the school” above.)
☐ Things you must not do, and things you agree to, regarding training 1. You must not take photos or videos during training, or post such material on the internet (social media, etc.). 2. You must not photograph or record any training without permission (this covers all lessons and courses, including classroom lessons, in-car lessons and tests). You must also not do anything that could look like photographing or recording — for example using a mobile phone or smartphone. Photographing the training record book is also prohibited. 3. If you are injured in an accident during training (including before and after lessons), you are normally responsible for this yourself, and we do not pay for medical treatment or any other costs.
